

I've Got My Emory I-20/DS-2019!

Now What?

- Verify that all information on your I-20/DS-2019 (and dependent I-20(s)/DS-2019(s) if applicable) is accurate. If you see any errors, contact your admitting school.
- Pay the SEVIS I-901 fee. Print and save your receipt.
- Apply for a student visa at a US embassy or consulate, if required.
- Become familiar with the requirements for maintaining your F-1/J-1 status.
- Check out the ISSS New Student Webpage.
- Make your travel arrangements in time for your Emory school's orientation (new F-1/J-1 students may enter the US no more than 30 days before the program start date listed on the I-20/DS-2019).
- Notify ISSS and your academic department as soon as possible if you are unable to enter the US by your program start date.
- Review Emory's immunization requirements and submit the Student Immunization Record via the Student Health Services online portal.
- Read Emory's health insurance requirements and learn about insurance for dependents, if applicable.
- Arrange for housing.

- Attend the ISSS Pre-Arrival Webinars.
- J-1 students who are sponsored by an organization other than Emory can contact your sponsor for pre-departure instructions.
- Contact your ISSS Advisor if you have questions.
